## SENIOR CHORUS

Sanctus . . . . . *Hassler 1564-1612*

Hassler was born in Nuremberg, and although his stay in Venice was short, his music was much influenced by the Venetian school. This Sanctus from Mass II is a short, but fine example of his work.

Kyrie . . . . . *Lotti 1667-1740*

Lotti's rank among musicians is a high one, his music being noted for its freedom and grace. This Kyrie from Mass V is in a beautiful flowing style.

## Chorale

"My Sin it is which binds me" . . . . . *Bach 1685-1750*

This chorale is from St. Mathew's Passion and comes just before the Institution of the Eucharist. Its grandeur is typical of Bach's chorales.
